Host Club Policies

Cell Phone Policy: Cell phones may only be used during the clinic in case of an emergency. We ask that phones are set to silent while on club grounds. Silent communications (text, email) may be used inside buildings. Verbal communication (phone calls) must be made outside buildings.

Parking: There is a limited amount of parking available at Bent Brook, and we ask that clinic participants and family members carpool as much as possible.

Dress Code: Appropriate golf attire must be worn. Males must wear tucked-in shirts with collars and sleeves, slacks, or Bermuda shorts. No cut-offs, denim, cargo pants or cargo shorts are permitted. Non-metal spikes only. Dress code applies to participants and spectators.

Coolers: Personal coolers are not allowed.

Personal Items: Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the Lakeshore Foundation, AGA, AL-NW FL PGA Section nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.
