# **Bent Brook Golf Club Policies (READ CAREFULLY)**

Cell Phone Policy: Cell phones may only be used on the golf course in case of an emergency, to call the golf shop in need of a ruling, view tournament leaderboard or as a distance measuring device. We ask that phones are set to silent while on club grounds. Silent communications (text, email) may be used inside buildings. Verbal communication (phone calls) must be outside buildings.

Dress Code: Appropriate golf attire must be worn. Slacks or Bermuda shorts. No jeans, or t-shirts allowed. No Metal Spikes. Accepted Forms of Payment: Club accepts CASH and CREDIT

# **Practice Rounds and Practice Facility**

You are entitled to <u>one</u> practice round on June 27<sup>th</sup>. You may call the golf shop (205-428-9600) to reserve a practice round tee time. Times are blocked off from 10:00-10:30am and 2:00-2:30pm. Make sure to identify yourself as a Alabama Girls' State Junior Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own group before calling. Do not, just show up at the course and expect to be accommodated for a practice round.

There is a \$4.00 fee the day of the practice round for range balls. Players are limited to playing one ball except from the teeing ground. Players are welcome to use the practice range and putting green throughout the championship.

# **Championship Format and Schedule**

Championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the championship.

Monday, June 27 All Day: Practice rounds.

8:00am-4:00pm: Player Registration in the Clubhouse.

Tuesday, June 28 Round 1: Tee Times starting at 8:00am.

Hosted player lunch after play at the club

Wednesday, June 29 Round 2: Tee Times starting at 8:00am

Hosted player lunch after play at the club

Thursday, June 30 Round 3: Tee times starting at 8:00am

Hosted player lunch after play at the club Awards ceremony immediately following play at scoreboard

#### **Starting Times**

# **Championship Cart and Range Fees; Push Carts**

All contestants are required to walk. There will be a \$4.00 range ball fee during the practice round, and all championship rounds range balls will be provided.

Personal push carts are allowed to be used during the championship.

# **Caddies**

Caddies are not allowed during this championship.

#### **Spectators**

We welcome and encourage spectators at all AGA competitions. The AGA, not the host club, determines whether spectator carts will be permitted during a competition. If carts are permitted on course, you must remain on the cart path at all times and stay up with the group you are following so as not to disturb play of the group immediately behind.

# **Food and Beverage**

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Bent Brook Grille. The Grille will be open to service all food needs beginning at 6:30am each morning.

#### **Hosted Player Lunches**

The AGA will provide lunches for players after play during Championship rounds. Lunch is provided for players only.

## **Championship Policies**

Bent Brook Golf Club is a soft-spike facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

Any player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a penalty of one stroke. A second violation will result in a two stroke penalty, followed by disqualification.

Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect (i.e. measure distance only) in this competition. A player may use a device to measure distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a function to measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.); the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

Compass and weather applications are now permitted on the device.
