Burningtree Country Club Policies (READ CAREFULLY)

Cell Phone Policy: Cell phones may only be used on the golf course in case of an emergency, to call the golf shop in need of a ruling, view tournament leaderboard or as a distance measuring device. We ask that phones are set to silent while on club grounds. Silent communications (text, email) may be used inside buildings. Verbal communication (phone calls) must be outside buildings.

Dress Code: Appropriate golf attire must be worn. No jeans or t-shirts allowed. No Metal Spikes.

Accepted Forms of Payment: Club accepts CASH and CREDIT.

Practice Rounds and Practice Facility

You are entitled to <u>one</u> practice round on September 14th. You may call the golf shop (256-355-5982) to reserve a practice round tee time as of September 6th. Make sure to identify yourself as an Alabama Women's State Four-Ball Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own group before calling. Do not, just show up at the course and expect to be accommodated for a practice round.

There is a \$25.00 fee per day including the practice round for a cart and range balls.

Players are limited to playing one ball except from the teeing ground.

Players are welcome to use the practice range and putting green throughout the championship.

Championship Format and Schedule

Championship is conducted at 36 holes of four-ball stroke play. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the championship.

Thursday, September 15 Round 1: Shotgun starting at 8:30am.

Starting Times

Starting times for September 15th will be available on September 14th by 5:00pm. Check the AGA website at www.Alabamagolf.org or call the AGA office.

Championship Cart and Range Fees; Push Carts

Cart and range fees for all championship rounds are paid by the contestant. Contestants have the option to walk or use a cart during championship rounds.

Personal push carts are allowed to be used during the championship.

Caddies

Caddies are permitted, but during the play of a hole, either the player or the caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time.

Spectators

Spectators are welcome at AGA championships however they are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed. Due to the limited number of available carts, spectator carts may not be available during the championship. Spectators are asked to remain on or near cart paths and adhere to the club's dress code policy.

Food and Beverage

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Burningtree Country Club. The Grill will be open to service all food needs beginning at 8:00am each morning.

Championship Policies

Burningtree Country Club is a soft-spike facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

Any player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a penalty of one stroke. A second violation will result in a two stroke penalty, followed by disqualification.

Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect (i.e. measure distance only) in this competition. A player may use a device to measure distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a function to measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.); the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

Compass and weather applications are now permitted on the device.
