

Men's Amateur and Senior Men's Amateur Player-of-the-Year

The Alabama Golf Association Men's Amateur Player of the Year Award and Senior Men's Amateur Player of the Year Award are determined by the number one ranked individual on the respective Alabama Men's Player Point Ranking at the end of each calendar year. Men's Amateur Player of the Year may be a player of any age. Senior Men's Amateur Player of the Year must be at least 50-years-old.

Separate amateur and senior point lists are maintained. It is the player's responsibility to notify the AGA of points earned in events held outside of Alabama.

Men's Southeastern Challenge Match Team Selection

The AGA selects a twelve player team to represent Alabama in this biannual competition against Florida and Georgia consisting of seven (7) Mid-Amateurs (25 and older), four (4) Senior Amateurs (two (2) players 50 and older; two (2) players 55 and older), and one (1) player 21 years and older. An individual must have competed in an AGA Championship within the last two years as of September 30, 2019 to be eligible. The team selections include:

- (1) Current State Senior Amateur Champion
- (1) Senior player with the highest point totals from the Alabama Senior Men's Amateur Rankings as of September 30, 2019
- (2) Senior Amateur player selected by the AGA Championship Committee
- (5) Mid-Amateur players with the highest point totals from the Alabama Men's Amateur Rankings as of September 30, 2019
- (2) Mid-Amateur players selected by the AGA Championship Committee
- (1) Amateur player 21 and older selected by the AGA Championship Committee

Any designated selections which are not filled due to ineligibility or other reason will be selected by the AGA Championships Committee.

The AGA Championship Committee reserves the right to deny participation by any player whose conduct is detrimental to the game of golf and might bring discredit on the AGA or Alabama.
