

2020 Alabama State Senior/Super-Senior Four-Ball Championship Timberline Golf Club, Calera, AL NOTICE TO PLAYERS

The Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA and R&A effective January 1, 2019 and the local rules on both sides of this sheet govern play at this AGA Championship. Disregard local rules printed on the club scorecard.

FORMAT, PLAYOFFS, AWARDS

54 holes of four-ball stroke play in both the Senior Championship and Super-Senior Championship.

After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the low 20 sides and ties in the Senior Championship, and the low 10 sides and ties in the Super-Senior Championship.

Senior Championship winners receive a trophy, gold medal and will have their names inscribed on the *Bob Phillips Trophy*. Second place receives a silver medal and third place receives a bronze medal.

Super-Senior Championship winners receive a trophy, gold medal and will have their names inscribed on the *Greer-Jungkind Trophy*. Second place receives a silver medal and third place receives a bronze medal. A tie for first place in the Senior Championship or the Super-Senior Championship will be settled by a hole-by-hole play-off on holes TBD. All other ties for merchandise are split equally. Merchandise distribution is posted at the scoring area.

OBSTRUCTIONS

Mesh netting is an immovable obstruction.

REPLACEMENT OF BROKEN OR SIGNIFICANTLY DAMAGED CLUBS

Model Local Rule G-9 is in effect

OUT OF BOUNDS

Defined by the line between course-side points, at ground level of white stakes, white dots, curbs of all public roads, fence left of #7 and fence surrounding maintenance area.

ΡΕΝΔΙΤΥ ΔΡΕΔΟ

Red Penalty Areas are defined by red lines. The railroad tracks left of holes #11 & #12 are in the penalty area. There is no free relief from the tracks.

GENERAL

a) Tees: Senior Championship - Blue AGA Tees Super-Senior Championship - Red AGA Tees

- **b)** Players must go to the scoring area in the clubhouse dining room to certify scores immediately following completion of the round.
- c) PACE OF PLAY See Separate Pace of Play Policy on the back of this sheet and scorecard for specific pace times.
- d) Weather Evacuation Plan: In the event of a suspension for a dangerous situation, all players must return to the clubhouse immediately following the horn.
- e) Rulings: Call AGA Rules Phone at 303-931-2621 and a rules official will be dispatched to your location as soon as possible
- f) Shelters are located: #5 Tee, #12 Tee, #14 Tee

COURSE MEASUREMENTS

- 1. Hole locations are measured from the front of the green along the line of play from the center of the fairway or teeing ground.
- 2. Yardage Adjust (i.e. +22) is the yardage to add to any yardage indicators, i.e. sprinkler heads or permanent markers.
- 3. Yardage on scorecards are to center of the green. Yardage on sprinkler heads on course are to the front of the green. Yardage adjust on permanent markers on Par-3 tees are to the front of green.
