















2020 Alabama State Senior & Super-Senior Amateur Championship Wynlakes Golf & Country Club, Montgomery, AL

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

The Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA and R&A effective January 1, 2019 and the local rules on both sides of this sheet govern play at this AGA Championship. Disregard local rules printed on the club scorecard.

FORMAT, CUT, PLAYOFFS, AWARDS

54 holes of gross individual stroke play. Players in the Senior Championship will play the Blue AGA Championship tees with the lowest score after 54 holes winning the Senior Amateur Championship title. Players in the Super-Senior Championship (65+) play the Red AGA tees with the lowest score after 54 holes winning the Super-Seńior Amateur Championship.

After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the low 36 players and ties in the Senior Championship Division and low 14 players and ties in the Super-Senior Championship.

In the event of a tie for first place in either the Senior or Super-Senior Championship, a hole-by-hole playoff will be held immediately following play. The playoff holes and order of play will be determined by the AGA. Ties for second or third place medals will be broken by a scorecard playoff using USGA recommended tiebreaking procedure. All ties for merchandise will be split equally except for first place. Merchandise distribution is posted in the scoring area. place. Merchandise distribution is posted in the scoring area.

REPLACEMENT OF BROKEN OR SIGNIFICANTLY DAMAGED CLUBS Model Local Rule G-9 is in effect.

OUT OF BOUNDS

a) Defined by the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes, small electrical boxes marked with "OB", white lines, property fences, waterside edge of stone wall between holes 16 & 18 and white dots on the ground. Where a white stake, line or dot is inside an "OB" electrical box the white stake, line or dot defines OB. When OB is defined by lines and stakes, the line itself is OB. Electrical "OB" boxes circled with Blue paint are deemed obstructions not OB markers.

b) Opposite pond grass bank left of Hole #6, right of Hole #13, left of Hole #17.

c) All public roads are out of bounds defined by the inside edge of the road curbing.

PENALTY AREAS

a) Concrete lined ditches are deemed to be Red penalty areas. The course-side edge of the concrete defines the margin.

b) Where there is no line, the waterside edge of stone retaining walls around penalty areas define the margin. Red or yellow stakes along the wall identify the type of penalty area. If there are no stakes then treat as a Red penalty area.

c) Hole #4 - As an additional option to Rule 17.1d for a ball known or virtually certain to be in the penalty area, the DROP ZONE (marked with DZ) located between the cart path and the penalty area may be used. A ball may be dropped anywhere in the closely mown area. .

PUTTING GREENS

a) Bare areas where the ball sits below the level of the ground on the putting green are ground under repair. Relief is for lie of ball only. Place the ball or another ball at the nearest point of complete relief. The nearest point of complete relief may be off the putting green.

b) Nursery Green left of Hole #13 is a Wrong Putting Green.

GENERAL

a) Tees:

Senior Championship: Blue AGA Tees Super-Senior Championship: Red AGA Tees

b) Pace of play: See scorecard for hole-by-hole time par.

c) Verbal certification of scores will be done in the scoring area located under the pavilion tent behind Hole #18 green adjacent to the clubhouse immediately following play. Scorecard is deemed returned when the player has exited the scoring area.
