## Championship History

This year marks the 110<sup>th</sup> playing of the Alabama Men's State Amateur Championship and the 11<sup>th</sup> time that The Country Club of Birmingham has hosted the State Amateur Championship. Bailey Sutter of Vinemont won the title in 2025 at RTJ Capitol Hill. The Championship was first played in 1915 at Montgomery Country Club in Montgomery, AL. Jack Allison of Birmingham, AL defeated Norborne R. Clarke 13 and 12 to win the inaugural event. The Championship was not played in 1917-18 due to World War I. Format was changed from match play to stroke play in 1955.

## Host Club Policies (READ CAREFULLY)

*Cell Phone Policy:* Cell phones may only be used on the golf course in case of an emergency, to call the golf shop in need of a ruling, view tournament leaderboard or as a distance measuring device. We ask that phones are set to silent while on club grounds. Silent communications (text, email) may be used inside buildings. Verbal communication (phone calls) must be outside buildings.

*Parking:* There is a limited amount of parking available at the host club and we ask that players, caddies and family members car pool as much as possible.

*Dress Code:* Appropriate golf attire must be worn. Slacks or Bermuda shorts. No cut-offs, no denim, no cargo pants or cargo shorts. Men must wear shirts with collars and sleeves, tucked in at all times. Non-metal spikes only. Dress code applies to caddies and spectators.

*Coolers:* Personal coolers are not allowed.

*Personal Items:* Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the AGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

*Accepted Forms of Payment:* Club accepts credit cards.

### Practice Rounds and Practice Facility

Official practice round will be on Tuesday, June 9. You must book tee time online through the Golf Genius tournament portal to schedule your practice round. Link will be made available no later than May 29. Do not just show up at the course and expect to be accommodated for a practice round. Practice round and the Championship will be walking only.

There is a mandatory \$35.00 fee for the practice round. Players are limited to playing one ball except from the teeing ground. Players are welcome to use the practice range and putting green throughout the championship.

### Starting Times

### Championship Format and Schedule

- This is a walking only Championship.
- The field will be cut to the low 60 players and ties after 36 holes.
- The lowest score for 72 holes will be the Champion.
- In the event of a tie for the Championship, a hole-by-hole play-off will be held immediately following play. The play-off holes and order of play will be determined by the Committee.
- Initial groupings will be for two days; the field will be cut and re-paired by score after the second round.

<b>Tuesday, June 9</b>	Practice rounds. 8:30am-3:30pm: Player Registration in the Clubhouse Foyer adjacent to the golf shop.
<b>Wednesday, June 10</b>	Round 1: Tee times begin at 7:30am & 12:30pm off #1 & #10 tees. 18 holes Stroke Play.
<b>Thursday, June 11</b>	Round 2: Tee times begin at 7:30am & 12:30pm off #1 & #10 tees. 18 holes Stroke Play. Cut to low 60 scores and ties. Field re-grouped according to score.
<b>Friday, June 12</b>	Round 3: Tee times begin at 7:30am off #1 & #10 tees. 18 holes Stroke Play. Field re-grouped according to score.
<b>Saturday, June 13</b>	Round 4: Tee times begin at 7:30am off #1 & #10 tees. 18 holes Stroke Play. Awards ceremony immediately following play at scoreboard.

### Pace of Play

The AGA wants all players to enjoy competing in our events. Pace of play may differ depending upon the venue, weather and course conditions. Every player is accountable for playing at an acceptable pace, therefore we need your help. Please observe the following guidelines to help ensure a pleasant tournament experience for all:

- Make sure to keep pace with the group in FRONT of you. The group behind should keep pace with your group and so forth.
- Go directly to your ball. If sharing a golf cart, drop-off the player farthest from the hole then proceed to the other ball.
- Be ready to play when it is your turn.
- Keep practice strokes and time taken to read putts to a minimum.
- Play a provisional ball if your original ball may be lost or out of bounds.
- Keep time taken at the snack bar or between nines to a minimum.

If everyone does their part, then 4½ hours should be the maximum time taken to play a round of golf at an AGA tournament. Following the lead of the USGA, the AGA has developed a pace of play policy, based on Rule 5.6b and Model Local Rule 8K that is fair to every competitor.

\*Note: a group may receive a "friendly reminder" of their position regardless of pace of play guidelines.

### Maximum Allowable Time

The maximum allowable time is the maximum time considered necessary by the Committee for a group to complete its round. This is expressed in a per-hole and aggregate time format and includes all time associated with playing the game, e.g., for rulings and walking times between holes.

Both the specific maximum time allotted per hole and for the completion of 18 holes at AGA championships will be denoted on each player's AGA issued scorecard.

### Cart/Range Fees; Push Carts

- *Practice Rounds:* Practice round fees are not included in the entry fee. Competitors must walk.
- *Championship Rounds:* Championship site fees are paid by the AGA and included in the entry fee. Competitors must walk. Personal push carts are allowed.

### Caddies

- *Caddies:* Caddies are not allowed for qualifying rounds. Caddies are allowed for championship rounds
- Caddies are required to wear an AGA issued caddie bib at the championship proper.

## Spectators

- *Spectator Golf Cart Policy:* Due to the limited number of available golf carts, spectator carts may not be available during the championship.
- *Disability Golf Cart Policy:* In consistency with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), AGA will grant an individual with a bona fide disability a golf cart if the following conditions are met:
  - Requesting individual completes and submits a [Disabled Golf Cart Request Form](#) by the close of entries date;
  - Host club has a golf cart available;
  - Requesting individual pays host club the appropriate fee;
  - Requesting individual presents to the AGA staff or AGA representative a disability card issued by a government agency
- Spectators must adhere to the club's dress code policy.
- Non-club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the [AGA Tournament Manual](#).

## Prizes

- *Sectional Qualifying Rounds:* Lowest Scorer for 18 Holes in each location: Silver medal; if a tie, duplicate medals will be awarded.
- *Championship:* Awards will be presented to the top three finishers. Merchandise prizes are awarded to the top finishers. Champion will have his name engraved on the *Sam Perry Trophy* and may take possession of the trophy for the ensuing year.
- Prizes in AGA amateur championships comply with USGA Rules of Amateur Status (see USGA Rules of Golf).
- High School or collegiate players should check with their institution compliance department regarding High School or NCAA regulations relating to accepting prizes or merchandise.

## Exemptions Earned

- Champion receives an exemption into the 2026 U.S. Amateur Championship, August 10-16, 2026 at Merion Golf Club in Ardmore, PA.
- Champion receives an exemption into the 2027 U.S. Amateur Championship Final Qualifying.
- Champion receives a lifetime exemption into the Alabama Men's State Amateur Championship.
- Champion receives 10 year exemption into the Alabama State Match Play Championship (2026-2035).
- Champion receives 10 year exemption into the Alabama State Mid-Amateur Championship (2026-2035) (must be 25 years of age or older by first day of Championship).
- The Top 5 Finishers will receive an exemption into the 2027 U.S. Amateur Championship Final Qualifying.
- Players finishing in the top 40 (and ties) will receive exemptions into the 2027 Alabama Men's State Amateur Championship and 2026 Alabama State Mid-Amateur Championship (must be 25 years of age or older by first day of Championship).
- Players finishing in the top 16 (and ties) will receive an exemption into the 2026 Alabama State Match Play Championship.

## Withdrawals

### QUALIFYING

**Withdrawal (All qualifiers and exempt players):** If an accepted player withdraws for any reason before the close of registration at **11:59pm on Thursday, May 7, 2026**, the entry fee will be refunded, subject to a \$30.00 service fee.

If an accepted player withdraws for any reason after the close of registration and before the deadlines listed below for any reason, 75% of the entry fee will be refunded. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after the deadlines listed below.

- Bessemer Qualifier - **11:59pm on Tuesday, May 12, 2026**
- Mobile Qualifier - **11:59pm on Tuesday, May 12, 2026**
- Jasper Qualifier - **11:59pm on Sunday, May 17, 2026**
- Auburn Qualifier - **11:59pm on Tuesday, May 19, 2026**
- Prattville Qualifier - **11:59pm on Sunday, May 24, 2026**

### CHAMPIONSHIP

**Successful Qualifier Withdrawal:** If a successful qualifier withdraws for any reason after paying his remaining championship balance of \$200 and before **11:59pm on Monday, June 8, 2026**, 75% of the remaining championship balance will be refunded. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after that time.

**Exempt Player Withdrawal:** If an exempt player withdraws for any reason before the close of registration at **11:59pm on Tuesday, May 7, 2026**, the entry fee will be refunded, subject to a \$30.00 service fee. If an exempt player withdraws for any reason after the close of registration and before **11:59pm on Monday, June 8, 2026**, 75% of the entry fee will be refunded. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after that time.

**No Shows:** Players that fail to notify the AGA of their withdrawal and “No Show” their starting time will not receive a refund for any reason. “No Show” players may be subject to suspension from future AGA events.

**Alternates:** Full refund if player does not gain entry into the championship.
