### Championship History

This year marks the 47<sup>th</sup> playing of the Southern Junior Championship and the first time that Idle Hour Country Club has hosted the Southern Junior Championship. Charlie Flynn, of Shreveport, Louisiana won the title in 2018 at Squire Creek Country Club in Choudrant, LA. The Championship was first played in 1973 with Buddy Rountree from Ft. Lauderdale, Florida winning the inaugural event. Charles Howell III, of Augusta, Georgia holds the record with 3 victories (1994-1996).

### Food and Beverage

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Idle Hour Country Club. The Cafe will be open to service all food needs beginning at 6:30am each morning. Dinner service is available from 5:30pm-9:00pm with required advance reservations.

The SGA will provide lunch for players from 11:00am-3:00pm for each round of the championship (Wednesday-Friday) in the clubhouse. Hosted lunch is for players only.

### Host Club Policies

*Cell Phone Policy:* Cell phones may only be used on the golf course in case of an emergency, to call the golf shop in need of a ruling, view tournament leaderboard or as a distance measuring device. We ask that phones are set to silent while on club grounds. Silent communications (text, email) may be used inside buildings. Verbal communication (phone calls) must be outside buildings.

**Parking:** There is a limited amount of parking available at the host club and we ask that players, caddies and family members car pool as much as possible.

**Dress Code:** Appropriate golf attire must be worn. Slacks or Bermuda shorts. No cut-offs, no denim, no cargo pants or cargo shorts. Men must wear shirts with collars and sleeves, tucked in at all times. Non-metal spikes only. Dress code applies to players, caddies and spectators.

**Coolers:** Personal coolers are not allowed. Bottled water will be available throughout the course.

**Personal Items:** Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the SGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

**Accepted Forms of Payment:** Club accepts **CASH**

### Practice Rounds and Practice Facility

Official practice round is on Tuesday, June 11. You must call the golf shop (859-266-1121) in advance to schedule your practice round beginning June 4<sup>th</sup>. Make sure to identify yourself as a Southern Junior Championship participant. Please do not show up at the course and expect to be accommodated for a practice round. Players are limited to playing one ball except from the teeing ground. Players are welcome to use the practice range and putting green throughout the championship.

### Range Fees; Push Carts

- *Practice Rounds:* Practice round fees are not included in the entry fee.
- *Championship Rounds:* All range fees during the championship rounds are paid by the SGA and are included in the entry fee. Competitors must walk during championship rounds. Push carts are permitted.

### Starting Times

Starting times for June 12-13 will be available on June 7<sup>th</sup> by 5:00pm. Check the SGA website at [www.southerngolf.org](http://www.southerngolf.org) or call the SGA office.

### Championship Format

- 54 holes of gross individual stroke play.
- The field will be cut to the low 66 players and ties after 36 holes.
- The lowest score for 54 holes will be the Champion.
- In the event of a tie for the overall Championship only, a hole-by-hole play-off will be held immediately following play. The play-off holes and their order of play will be determined by the Committee.
- Initial groupings will be for two days; the field will be cut and re-paired by score after the second round for the third round.

### Championship Schedule

<b>Tuesday, June 11</b>	All Day: Practice rounds. 8:00am-5:00pm: Player Registration in the Clubhouse.
<b>Wednesday, June 12</b>	Round 1: Tee times at 7:30am & 12:30pm off #1 & #10 tees. 11:00am-3:00pm: Hosted player lunch.
<b>Thursday, June 13</b>	Round 2: Tee times at 7:30am & 12:30pm off #1 & #10 tees. 11:00am-3:00pm: Hosted player lunch. Cut to low 66 scores and ties. Field re-grouped according to score.
<b>Friday, June 14</b>	Round 3: Tee times at 7:30am off #1 & #10 tees. 11:00am-3:00pm: Hosted player lunch. Awards ceremony immediately following play at scoreboard.

### Prizes & Awards

Awards will be presented to the top three finishers. Champion will have his name engraved on the *Perry Adair Trophy* that is housed in the SGA Office. Ties for second and third place will be determined using the USGA recommended score card playoff procedure to break ties (last 9 (Holes 10-18), last 6 (Holes 13-18), last 3 (Holes 16-18), 18<sup>th</sup> hole, 1<sup>st</sup> hole, 2<sup>nd</sup> hole, etc. until the tie is broken).

*State Team Competition* – All U.S. players are automatically entered into The State Team competition. Each state is comprised of the low four players from the same state. State residency is determined by the player's home address listed on their entry application. The State Team winner is determined after the first 36 holes of play. Each of the winning team members receives an award. In the event of a tie, the aggregate score of all team members from round two will be used. If there is still a tie, then round one aggregate score is used.

#### **Exemptions Earned**

- Champion receives an exemption into the 2019 and 2020 Southern Amateur Championship
- Champion receives an exemption into all future Southern Junior Championships in which he is eligible to compete
- Champion receives Fully Exempt Status with AJGA
- 2<sup>nd</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> places receive AJGA Stars (see AJGA.org website)

#### **Caddies; Spectators; Golf Cart Requests**

- *Caddies*; Caddies are not allowed.
- *Spectators*: SGA welcomes spectators at our championships. For your safety, we request that spectators walk near the cart path at all times.
- *Disabled Golf Cart Policy*: In consistency with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), SGA will grant an individual with a bona fide disability a golf cart if the following conditions are met:
  1. Requesting individual completes and submits a [Disabled Golf Cart Request Form](#) by the close of entries;
  2. Host club has a golf cart available;
  3. Requesting individual pays host club the appropriate cart fee;
  4. Requesting individual presents to the SGA representative a handicap card issued by a government agency.

**Pace of Play:** The SGA wants all players to enjoy competing in our events. Pace of play may differ depending upon the venue, weather and course conditions. Every player is accountable for playing at an acceptable pace, therefore we need your help. Please observe the following guidelines to help ensure a pleasant tournament experience for all:

- Make sure to keep pace with the group in FRONT of you. The group behind should keep pace with your group and so forth.
- Go directly to your ball. If sharing a golf cart, drop-off the player farthest from the hole then proceed to the other ball.
- Be ready to play when it is your turn.
- Keep practice strokes and time taken to read putts to a minimum.
- Play a provisional ball if your original ball may be lost or out of bounds.
- Keep time taken at the snack bar or between nines to a minimum.

If everyone does their part, then 4½ hours should be the maximum time taken to play a round of golf at an SGA tournament. Your SGA issued score card will have the acceptable pace of play per hole printed on it.

#### **Pace of Play Policy**

A group that is out of position will be advised of the situation and the individuals may be timed.

- Any competitor who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a warning for slow play and will be advised of the fact.
- The competitor will be notified that exceeding 40 seconds on one more occasion will result in a penalty of one stroke in stroke play or loss of hole in match play. A third violation will result in a two stroke penalty in stroke play or loss of hole in match play, followed by disqualification for a fourth violation.
- A warning is any notice given to a competitor regarding pace of play.
- A competitor's time to play begins when the competitor has had a reasonable opportunity to reach his or her ball and when it is the competitor's turn to play and can do so without interference or distraction. Penalties are applied individually, but more than one competitor in a group may be penalized.
- In general, competitors in a group are subject to being timed at any time but specifically when the group is deemed to be out of position and over the allotted pace of play guidelines.

Note that a group that is out of position at any time may be asked to close the gap regardless of pace of play guidelines. A group is out of position if they are over their maximum acceptable pace of play and more than 15 minutes behind the group ahead of them. The first group off either side is out of position if they are over their maximum acceptable pace of play.

#### **Championship Policies**

- This is a soft-spike facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

#### **Withdrawals**

If an accepted player withdraws for any reason before the close of registration at **11:59 P.M., Tuesday, May 28, 2019**, the entry fee will be refunded, subject to a \$50.00 service fee. If an accepted player withdraws for any reason after the close of registration and before **11:59 P.M., Sunday, June 9, 2019**, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after **11:59 P.M., Sunday, June 9, 2019**. **No Shows**

Players that fail to notify the SGA of their withdrawal and "No Show" their starting time will not receive a refund for any reason. "No Show" players may be subject to suspension from future SGA events.
