Championship History

This year marks the 115th playing of the Southern Amateur Championship and the second time that Old Waverly Golf Club has hosted the Southern Amateur Championship. McClure Meissner of San Antonio, TX won the title in 2020 at Maridoe Golf Club in Carrollton, TX with a score of 281 (-7).

The Championship was first played in 1902 at Nashville Golf & Country Club in Nashville, TN. A.F. Schwartz of New Orleans, LA defeated Percy Whiting 4 and 2 to win the inaugural event. The Championship was not played in 1918 due to World War I and 1942-1945 due to World War II. Format was changed from match play to stroke play in 1964. [Southern Amateur Past Champions](#)

Hosted Player Lunch on July 14-17

The SGA will provide lunch for players from 11:00am-3:00pm on Wednesday-Saturday in the clubhouse. Hosted lunch is for players only. Caddies and spectators may purchase food and beverage at several club locations.

Closest airport is Golden Triangle Regional Airport in Columbus, MS (GTR). GTR Airport is 24 minutes from Old Waverly Golf Club. All airline carriers have daily flights to GTR.

Please note that players are responsible for their own accommodations and transportation.

Old Waverly Golf Club Policies

Cell Phone Policy: Cell phones may only be used on the golf course in case of an emergency, to call the golf shop in need of a ruling, view tournament leaderboard or as a distance measuring device. We ask that phones are set to silent while on club grounds. Silent communications (text, email) may be used inside buildings. Verbal communication (phone calls) must be outside buildings.

Parking: This will be a very busy week at Old Waverly Golf Club with the tournament and normal club activities. Parking will be available on-site at Old Waverly Golf Club. However, we request for players, caddies and family members car pool as much as possible.

Dress Code: Appropriate golf attire must be worn. Slacks or Bermuda shorts. No cut-offs, no denim, no cargo pants or cargo shorts. Men must wear shirts with collars and sleeves, tucked in at all times. Non-metal spikes only. Dress code applies to caddies and spectators. Please remove hats while inside the clubhouse.

Coolers: Personal coolers are not allowed. Bottled water will be available throughout the golf course.

Personal Items: Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the SGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Accepted Forms of Payment: Club accepts cash and credit card. MasterCard/Visa may be used.

Practice Rounds and Practice Facility

Official practice round is on Tuesday, July 13. You must call the golf shop (662-494-8780) in advance to schedule your practice round for this day. Make sure to identify yourself as a Southern Amateur Championship participant. Please do not show up at the course and expect to be accommodated for a practice round. Players are limited to playing one ball except from the teeing ground. Players are welcome to use the practice range, short game area and putting green throughout the championship. *Note that the practice range may close early for maintenance each evening.

Starting Times

Starting times for July 14-15 will be available on July 9th by 5:00pm. Check the SGA website at www.southerngolf.org and a link will be sent to each player via text message.

Championship Format

- The field will be cut to the low 66 players and ties after 36 holes.
- The lowest score for 72 holes will be the Champion.
- In the event of a tie for the Championship, a "sudden death" hole-by-hole play-off will be held immediately following play. The play-off holes and their order of play will be determined by the Committee.
- Initial groupings will be for the first two rounds; the field will be cut and re-grouped by score after the second round for the third round; field re-grouped by score for the fourth round.

Prizes

- Awards will be presented to the three lowest scores after 72 holes. Champion will have his name engraved on the *George W. Adair Trophy*, which is enshrined in the Bob Jones Room of the Atlanta Athletic Club, Atlanta, Georgia.

Exemptions Earned

- Champion receives a five-year exemption into the Southern Amateur Championship (2022-2026).
- Players finishing in the top 10 (and ties) receive an exemption into the 2022 Southern Amateur Championship.

Championship Schedule

11:00am- 3:00pm: Hosted player lunch.
Cut to low 66 scores and ties.
Field re-grouped according to score.

Friday, July 16

Round 3: Tee times begin at 7:30am off #1 & #10 tees. 18 holes of Stroke Play.
11:00am-3:00pm: Hosted player lunch.
Field re-grouped according to score.

Saturday, July 17

Round 4: Tee times begin at 7:30am off #1 & #10 tees. 18 holes of Stroke Play.

11:00am-3:00pm: Hosted player lunch.
Awards ceremony immediately following play at scoreboard.

Championship Policies

- Competitors and caddies must walk at all times during practice and championship rounds.
- This is a soft-spike facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

Range Fees; Push Carts

- Practice and championship round range fees are paid by the SGA.
- Personal push carts are permitted.

Caddies

- Caddies are permitted for practice and championship rounds. Caddies and players must walk at all times during the round except where authorized shuttles are provided. Caddies are not available at the Host Club.
- Caddies are required to wear an SGA issued caddie bib at the championship proper. Bibs will be available at the designated starting tee and must be returned to the SGA at the conclusion of each round.

Spectators and Cart Requests

- *Spectators:* SGA welcomes spectators at our championships. For your safety, we request that spectators walk near the cart path at all times. Spectator carts are generally not available except as provided in the *Disabled Golf Cart Policy*.
- *Disabled Golf Cart Policy:* In consistency with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), SGA will grant an individual with a bona fide disability a golf cart if the following conditions are met:
 1. Requesting individual completes and submits a [Disabled Golf Cart Request Form](#) by the close of entries;
 2. Host club has a golf cart available;
 3. Requesting individual pays host club the appropriate cart fee;
 4. Requesting individual presents to the SGA staff or SGA representative a handicap card issued by a government agency.

Pace of Play

The SGA wants all players to enjoy competing in our events. Pace of play may differ depending upon the venue, weather and course conditions. Every player is accountable for playing at an acceptable pace, therefore we need your help. Please observe the following guidelines to help ensure a pleasant tournament experience for all:

- Make sure to keep pace with the group in FRONT of you. The group behind should keep pace with your group and so forth.
- Go directly to your ball. If sharing a golf cart, drop-off the player farthest from the hole then proceed to the other ball.
- Be ready to play when it is your turn.
- Keep practice strokes and time taken to read putts to a minimum.
- Play a provisional ball if your original ball may be lost or out of bounds.
- Keep time taken at the snack bar or between nines to a minimum.

If everyone does their part, then 4½ hours should be the maximum time taken to play a round of golf at an SGA tournament. Your SGA issued score card will have the acceptable pace of play per hole printed on it.

Pace of Play Policy

A group that is out of position will be advised of the situation and the individuals may be timed.

- Any competitor who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a warning for slow play and will be advised of the fact.
- The competitor will be notified that exceeding 40 seconds on one more occasion will result in a penalty of one stroke in stroke play or loss of hole in match play. A third violation will result in a two stroke penalty in stroke play or loss of hole in match play, followed by disqualification for a fourth violation.
- A warning is any notice given to a competitor regarding pace of play.
- A competitor's time to play begins when the competitor has had a reasonable opportunity to reach his or her ball and when it is the competitor's turn to play and can do so without interference or distraction. Penalties are applied individually, but more than one competitor in a group may be penalized.
- In general, competitors in a group are subject to being timed at any time but specifically when the group is deemed to be out of position and over the allotted pace of play guidelines.

Note that a group that is out of position at any time may be asked to close the gap regardless of pace of play guidelines. A group is out of position if they are over their maximum acceptable pace of play and more than 15 minutes behind the group ahead of them. The first group off either side is out of position if they are over their maximum acceptable pace of play.

Withdrawals

Successful Qualifier Withdrawal: If a successful qualifier withdraws for any reason after paying his remaining championship balance of \$175.00 and before **11:59pm CST on Sunday, July 11, 2021**, 50% of the remaining championship balance will be refunded. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after **Sunday, July 11, 2021**.

To withdraw from the event before the close of registration, follow these steps:

- 1) Navigate to the Championship Website Portal.
- 2) Sign In to your SGA Tournament Registration Account.
- 3) Click "Edit Registration" from left side of page.

4) Choose "Cancel Registration" under dropdown menu on right side of page.
To withdraw from the event after the close of registration, complete the [Online Tournament Withdrawal Form](#).
*Note: SGA will process your withdrawal and applicable refund within 72 hours.

No Shows

Players that fail to notify the SGA of their withdrawal and "No Show" their starting time will not receive a refund for any reason. "No Show" players may be subject to suspension from future SGA events.
